FINE ARTS - SCHEDULE

Students will not be led by a given schedule, but have to organize a schedule by themselves. Class professors will inform about class appointments and requirements and of course feedback concepts, projects and artistic work. In addition, students need to organize e.g. appointments with study workshop lecturers themselves. The International Office will offer support.

GRADES

Artistic work in Fine Arts and Art Education is graded with passed or failed. Theory classes only will be issued with numeric grades on the Transcript of Records, and only if students hand in seminar papers or other required works as named by the responsible theory professors or lecturers.
