

## Factsheet „Learning Agreement & Anrechnung von Auslandsleistungen“

### Innenarchitektur/ Interior Design – BA & MA

- Basically, the Learning Agreement does not confirm the crediting of your degree programme.
- Please enter in the Learning Agreement in the table "Recognition at the Sending Institution" exactly these courses/seminars/lectures and the corresponding ECTS you want to take abroad (table "Receiving Institution"). However, please enter the abbreviation **FU** for optional lessons in the table "Recognition at the Sending...". This indicates the contents of the course as additional services, but not eligible for your study progression. By signing the Learning Agreement, you agree to non-crediting.
- In the case of "Beurlaubung", no benefits are in principle eligible. However, a Learning Agreement must always be drawn up as described above.
- Regardless of whether, which and how many credits and ECTS have been certified, passed or failed according to the Learning Agreement or according to the Transcript of Records, you will always receive the Erasmus funding awarded to you. It is only relevant that you present a Learning Agreement and a "certificate of the home university" at KOOR after returning from abroad. The amount of ECTS achieved, completed or passed is not relevant for your Erasmus funding.
